The extension of the MDHHS order is frustrating but is also our reality. We want our kids back in school now, not after Christmas break. Thankfully, we found an option to do exactly this. The schedule below outlines when your child can attend school. On these dates, students will receive tutoring, academic support, and direct help from their teachers supplemental to what is happening in Google Classrooms. Students should bring their Chromebook (if they have one) and will attend all seven periods each day for academic support. Buses will run as usual and masking is required. Attendance is not required, however, this provides an opportunity for students to get help from their teachers.

- December 10, 14, 16, and 18 Grades 10 and 12

Looking forward, we will also be changing our 1st semester exam week. Student exams will not count for 20% of semester grades. Smaller assessments will still take place with the primary goal of determining gaps in learning for future instruction.
